

## **Rewards and Praise**

### **Saver Point System**

In the classroom -

You will receive lots of verbal praise, learning points, praise postcards, achievement certificates and nominations for student of the week if you -

- Arrive on time
- Listen when asked
- Get on task quickly and without fuss.
- Complete the work you are set to do.
- Show determination in your work and respect for others around you.
- Work well in a group or individually.
- Try to answer questions and get involved with lesson.
- Work to the best of your ability.

All of your praises will be recorded -

**A1 = You get 1 Enterprise point**

**A2 = If you receive a praise postcard  
you get 5 Enterprise points**

**A3 = A praise certificate gets you  
10 Enterprise points**

**A4 = Being nominated for student of the  
week gets you 20 Enterprise points**

These Enterprise points are part of a Saver Scheme and can be saved and exchanged if you chose for rewards such as vouchers and trips or spent on smaller items – such as food!

### **What happens if you disrupt the learning of others...**

Teachers and teaching assistants use many different ways of making sure your lessons are interesting and ensure you have the best opportunities to learn. In order to manage the classroom teachers and teaching assistants use different strategies to help students engage and behave well - a seating plan, moving students who talk at the wrong time, refocusing students on task etc... All staff are told to give students every chance to get on task before using the Climate 4 Learning system.

The Climate 4 Learning system is based on a series of choices of poor behaviour that disrupts the learning of others. It allows you to choose to get back on task and avoid further consequences.

Teachers will try their strategies, however, if you chose to behave inappropriately you will be issued with a:

**C1**  
**Verbal Warning about your**  
**behaviour** Your teacher will tell you that you have started on the choice ladder and **you**



**C2**  
**Verbal Warning about your**  
**Behaviour - logged in Sleuth**  
**Lose 2 Enterprise points**



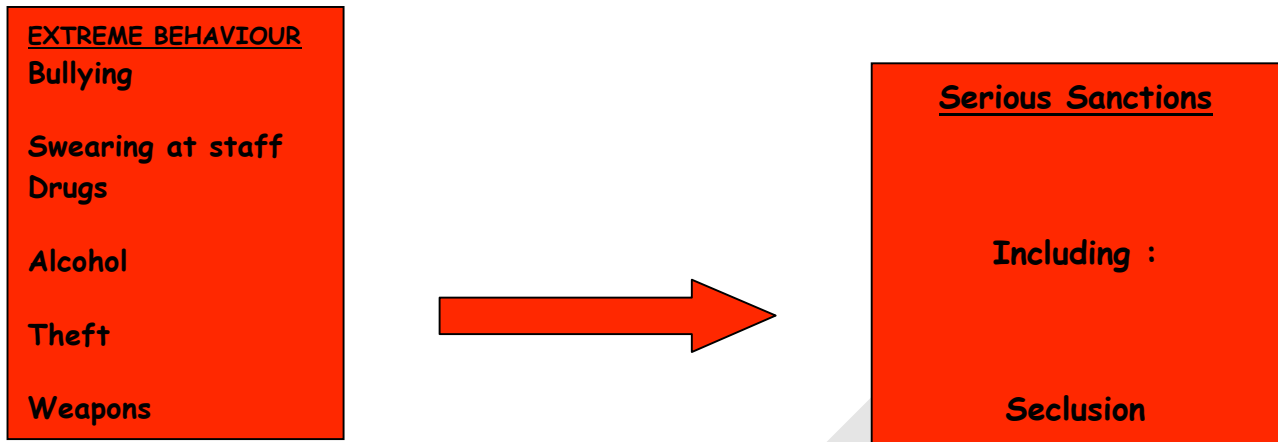
**C3**  
**Verbal Warning about your**  
**Behaviour - logged in Sleuth & 30 minute detention**  
**Lose 5 Enterprise points**



**C4**  
**Lose 10 Enterprise Points**  
**Removed from classroom by a member of Senior Staff.**  
**Automatic 1 hour detention. Complete the SLEUTH referral form and return it.**

Although this system is new to you it is based on things that you are already familiar with and understand. This system puts it all together for you.



The Academy community has high standards so... we do not expect any of the following -

Students know and understand we do not accept:

Lateness to lesson	Inappropriate Uniform
Chewing Gum	No Homework
Disturbing others	Lack of Equipment
Disturbing lessons	Littering / rubbish
TOOTING / Not on task	Out of bounds

**These rules are here to help you and keep you safe.**

Your parents/carers have a booklet that explains this system to them and they are invited to feedback to Academy.

Staff have their own booklet and they have been asked to be consistent, fair and professional. As always they will prepare and deliver the best lessons with enthusiasm and commitment.

Outside the Classroom Behaviour

(OCB)



The way in which students behave and relate to each other and adults outside the classroom is very important. Behaviour at Brunch and Lunch and moving from lesson to lesson should be of a high standard to ensure the safety and happiness of all.

**Rewards** - Outside the classroom staff will reward you for good behaviour. Things such as excellent uniform, being helpful, holding doors, being polite, caring for others etc... will be rewarded in the following ways :

All of your praises will be recorded -

- A1 = You get a citizenship point
- A2 = If you receive a praise postcard you get 5pts
- A3 = A praise certificate gets you 10pts
- A4 = Being nominated for citizen of the week gets you 20pts

### **What happens if you misbehave outside the classroom?**

We **do not** accept anti social behaviour, being out of bounds, shouting & running in the Academy building, eating food in the corridors or dropping rubbish.

Students **who choose** to behave poorly around Academy may be issued with the following : (O2 onwards = recorded in Sleuth)

- O1 = This will be a firm word from a member of staff
- O2 = OCB detention for 20 minutes after Academy the next day -2 pts
- O3 = YCC/KSL detention for 30 minutes - 5pts
- O4 = LG detention for 1 hour - 10pt
